Beginning in the 2013-14 school year our school district implemented the Charlotte Danielson Framework for Teaching (2007) as the model for teacher evaluation to improve teaching and learning as required by the State of New Jersey.

Also continuing this school year, The Marshall Principal Evaluation Rubric is being used as the Principal and Supervisor evaluation model to improve school and district leadership and student achievement.

Each school in our district is required to have a School Improvement Panel (SciP). This panel consists of principals and teachers. This panel is responsible for overseeing the evaluation process, the mentoring of new teachers and identifying professional development opportunities for staff. Our Supervisor of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment, Kerridyn Trusheim, will work with each school panel as needed. Twice a year a combined meeting of all SciP's meets as the District Evaluation Advisory Committee (DEAC).
