Dear SRD Families,

Happy New Year! I hope this letter finds you and your family in good health.

On Monday, February 1st, 2021, as part of our reentry Restart and Recovery Plan, we will be welcoming students back to school following a Hybrid early dismissal schedule consisting of Cohorts A and B. Each cohort will now attend school for a full week, including Wednesday. Therefore, on February 1st, Cohort A will report for the entire week while Cohort B will attend class synchronously (virtual). On February 8th, Cohort B will attend in person and Cohort A will be home virtually. Students with an academic IEP will be contacted by their case manager to discuss scheduling options.

Below are important details about the return of our students to **Samuel R Donald School:**

As we did in November, parents must complete a Daily COVID form in Realtime by 7:30 AM - prior to sending their child(ren) to school. Students will not be allowed into their classroom until it is completed for the safety of all students. You will receive a phone call from the school if it is not completed. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

- Cohort C (virtual learners) will be expected to attend all classes.

- Cohort A will work virtually from home utilizing Google Meet/Classroom
- Cohort C (virtual learners) will be expected to attend all classes.

Please note that school is closed on Friday, February 12 and Monday, February 15.

- Students will remain in their current cohorts. If a parent wishes to change from in-person to virtual or vise versa they <u>must notify the principal no later than Friday</u>, <u>January 15</u>.

- Any request after February 1st for a change in schedule from virtual to in-person will require a month's notice due to scheduling and transportation. Parental requests should be sent to **the building principal.**
- Any request to go virtual will be immediate upon notice to the Main Office.
- All virtual students will log in through their Google Classroom by **8:20 AM**.
- Attendance will be taken on a daily basis. If your child will be absent from school either virtually or in-person, please contact the Main Office or the School Nurse. The School Nurse will call home if you do not contact us. A well-visit will occur if we can't reach you within a reasonable timeframe.
- RELATED ARTS CLASSES will be all virtual from 1:10 PM 1:40 PM daily. All students should follow the schedule below.
- ACADEMIC ASSISTANCE/ Small Groups instruction will be available from 1:00 PM 1:40 PM daily.



ARRIVAL:

- Screenings at your child's entry door are from 8:00-8:15am.
- After 8:15am you will be required to go to the main door and ring the bell.
- Arriving after 8:25am is considered a tardy.
- Logging in after 8:25 am on remote days is considered tardy.

DEPARTURE:

- Please be at your child's door by 12:10pm for dismissal. Wait outside your child's door for them to exit the building. REMAIN socially distant from others.
- Please do not block buses during dismissal.

At all times on school property, a mask must be worn and social distancing must be followed.

HEALTH PROCEDURES

- *Before students enter the building each morning for in-person instruction, a COVID questionnaire stating that your child is symptom free must be filled out. This form is located in the Realtime Parent Portal forms section. Please make this part of your daily routine before bringing your child to school or to the bus stop. We are asking that this be done by 7:30 AM*
- Staff will be diligent in monitoring their students for signs of illness. Any student exhibiting illness symptoms will be sent to the nurse for a temperature check. Students with a temperature of 100.4 degrees F or higher/or exhibiting signs of COVID-19 will be sent to an isolation room to await parent/guardian pick-up. Parents will sign their student out using their own pen and they will meet the school nurse and pick up their child.
- Anyone who suspects they are ill and received a COVID-19 test should not attend or visit school while
 awaiting test results. Should the test result be negative, they should follow normal illness exclusion rules
 (typically 24 hours without fever before they can return to school). If a clinician has a suspicion that the

- illness may be COVID-19 despite a negative test, they should follow general guidance related to
- COVID-19 ie, unless they were immunocompromised, they would wait at least 10 days from symptom onset and at least one day from resolution of symptoms prior to returning. If the individual should be quarantined based upon a known exposure, then they would need to wait 14 days from the last possible exposure prior to returning. A medical note with clearance is required to return to school.
- If a student tests positive for Covid and has been in school, the school district will follow these procedures: Lab results that demonstrate a positive test are reported to the Department of Health through a doctor's office. HIPPA regulations prohibit a person's name or personal information to be shared publicly. School officials and the Department of Health will work together to contact trace and notify any potential students or staff that were exposed to a COVID positive case and follow up with the student's parent/guardian to answer questions and provide instruction.
- Following a positive test result, a student may return to school based on the following: A negative test is not necessary to return to school. CDS follows CDC guidelines, which provide that persons with COVID-19 who have symptoms and were directed to care for themselves at home may discontinue isolation under the following conditions:
 - At least 10 days* have passed since symptom onset, and
 - At least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications, and
 - Other symptoms have improved.
- If a student or a students' family has been in a state that is on the New Jersey Quarantine list, the student must self-quarantine for 14 days prior to reporting back to school.
- If a member of our learning community has been in contact with or is living with someone who has COVID-19, he or she is required to remain home. Students will be expected to continue to learn virtually during the mandated quarantine time.
- The school will maintain an adequate supply of gloves, masks, and other PPE.
- Touchless thermometers are on-site for employee and student screening if applicable.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Students will be able to bring a healthy snack to school.
- Students will be able to remove their mask when eating or drinking following socially distant guidelines.
- Until further notice, Maschio's Food Services will be providing free Grab and Go lunches to all students. These will be delivered to classrooms prior to dismissal. Lunch will take place in the student's home.
- Students may bring their own water bottle to school. Classroom/hallway water fountains will not be in use.
- Students and staff will wear a mask at all times inside the school building. Mask breaks will be provided daily.
- Student desks/tables will be spread out as far as possible to facilitate social distancing.
- Students will maintain personal supplies and will not share items.
- Students will be encouraged to wash their hands frequently and to use the many hand sanitizer dispensers spread throughout the building.
- Classrooms will be sanitized at the end of the school day. The custodial staff will provide routine cleaning and disinfecting of bathrooms throughout each school day and evening.
- All hallways will have floor markings for social distancing.

As a reminder, if you choose to change your schedule from in-person to virtual or vise versa, starting on February 1st, you must notify my office by this Friday, January 15.
